

Limited Registered Warranty for TEGOLA CANADESE Asphalt Shingles.

Congratulations on your purchase of TEGOLA CANADESE asphalt shingles. Tegola Canadese Srl has more than 40 years experience in the manufacture of high-quality roof shingles in the whole world. TEGOLA CANADESE offers warranties for integrative coverage periods compared to the warranties duration provided by the applicable law, as provided in the Information Table Below.

This document explains the details of the limited warranty Tegola Canadese Srl provided for your Shingles installed on your roof. Please read it carefully to ensure you are well-informed about the warranty coverage granted by this Limited Registered Warranty. Please note that your Contractor, as defined below, is not an employee or representative of Tegola Canadese Srl. Tegola Canadese Srl is not bound by any guarantees, warranties or representations made by your Contractor or building materials reseller. This TEGOLA CANADESE Limited Registered Warranty and your coverage is detailed in this document. If you have questions about that coverage, contact Tegola Canadese Srl directly.

Tegola Canadese Srl declares that possible slight alterations of the color of the Shingles due to the exposition on the roof are not considered defects or non-conformities of the shingles for the purpose of this TC Limited Registered Warranty.

1. Definitions:

"TEGOLA CANADESE" means Tegola Canadese Srl with legal seat in Via dell'Industria, 21 -31029 Vittorio Veneto- Italy- Tax number 00449930262.

"Pro-rate" means the pro-rate period of the Warranty Period starting from the Date of Purchase of the Shingle by the first owner until the date of official claim for defects as listed in this TEGOLA CANADESE Limited Registered Warranty accepted and recorded by TEGOLA CANADESE, and covered by this TEGOLA CANADESE Limited Registered Warranty.

"Warranty Period" means the total coverage period provided by Tegola Canadese Srl on the Shingles under this TEGOLA CANADESE Limited Registered Warranty. The duration of the Warranty Period for each model of Shingle is listed in the Information Table below.

"Manufacturing Defects" means the manufacturing defects of the Shingles pursuant to the terms and conditions of this TC Limited Registered Warranty which result in a leak.

"Max Protection" means the limited non prorated coverage provided by the TEGOLA CANADESE Limited Registered Warranty during the Max Protection Period. Please read the section titled "TEGOLA CANADESE Max Protection Period" for more details on this coverage. The duration of the Max Protection period for each model of Shingle is listed in the Information Table below.

"Max Protection Period" means the initial period of the Warranty Period, as provided in the Information Table, during which Tegola Canadese Srl provides Max Protection coverage. Please read the section titled "TEGOLA CANADESE Max Protection Period" for more details. The duration of the Max Protection period for each model of Shingle is listed in the Information Table below.

"Beyond Max Protection Period" means the portions of the Warranty Period during which the Limited Registered Warranty is reduced applying to the Maximum Liability the reduction factors as per the Information Table below. Such reductions shall be calculated considering (a) the first period of the Warranty Period starting from the Date of Purchase up to 180 months including the Max Protection Period, and (b) the remaining period, which differs for each type of Product, after the expiration of the first 180 months from the Date of Purchase.

"Limited Registered Warranty" means the limited warranties and coverage provided by Tegola Canadese Srl for the Shingles as expressly set out in this document, and are the only warranties being provided by Tegola Canadese Srl. In order to supply a precise and serious service, Tegola Canadese Srl requires the registration of this Limited Registered Warranty, at the Italian headquarters of TEGOLA CANADESE, in order to make it effective. The registration is possible under the First Owner's formal request and submission of the following documents to Tegola Canadese Srl within twelve (12) months from the sales invoice date of Tegola Canadese Srl, by sending the request of issuing Limited Registered Warranty to: warranty@tegolacnadese.com. The First Owner shall send:

A Declaration of acceptance of the conditions of Limited Registered Warranty of Tegola Canadese;

B Tegola Canadese original Sales Invoice and/or Declaration from Tegola's customer with Tegola's original Sales Invoice Date and number,

Production Batch, and all relevant information for issuing the Limited Registered Warranty

C complete address of the place of installation of the Shingles with pictures of the roof during installation.

D copy of the invoice for installation of Shingles, showing the installation costs.

Once Tegola Canadese has checked and approved positively all the submitted data, Tegola Canadese Srl will provide the official Limited Registered Warranty document, signed and stamped on all its pages. The installation must be done within eight (8) months from Tegola's Sales Invoice Date to its customer, and is subject to the payment of the concerned Invoice.

Should any leakage occur, the first owner must inform Tegola Canadese within 30 days from the discovery of it by adding documentation / pictures of what occurred. The owner is required not to modify the status of the roof, until Tegola Canadese has studied and proposed a solution, to be given within 30 days from receipt of the documentation, by also communicating if leakage is due to an accepted problem of Tegola Canadese shingles. In case some unauthorized reparations are run, the Limited Registered Warranty is no longer valid.

"Maximum Liability" means the maximum obligation of Tegola Canadese Srl under the Limited Registered Warranty, as described in the sections titled "Max Protection Period", "Beyond Max Protection Period", "Limited Wind Resistance Warranty" and "AR coverage months", whichever is applicable. Please read each of these sections carefully for more details.

"Wind Speed Coverage" means the total speed expressed in km/h under which Tegola Canadese Srl covers each model of Shingles.

"AR" means Shingles which are covered by the Limited Algae Resistance Warranty set out herein in the Limited Registered Warranty Information Table below. Please read carefully Par. 7 of this Limited Registered Warranty

"First Owner or Owner" means the owner of the building at the time that the Shingles were installed for the first time on that building.

"Contractor" means the contractor or the roofer entrusted by the First Owner who performs the installation of the Shingles;

"Date of the Sales Invoice" or **"Sales Date"** means the date when Tegola sold Shingles to its customer.

"Date of Installation" means the date of the first installation of the Shingles on the roof as provided in the invoice issued by the Contractor;

"Date of Purchase" means the date in which the Shingles have been Purchased by the First Owner as indicated in the Declaration containing all data of Tegola Canadese Sales Invoice

"Shingle" or **"Shingles"** means the TEGOLA asphalt shingle product, excluded Tegola Ultimetal HD specifically described at point 13 of this Limited Registered Warranty, identified in this Limited Registered Warranty that was installed on the roof of the building owned by the First Owner.

"Information Table" means the Limited Registered Warranty Information Table below.

In addition to any other specific conditions set forth in this Limited Registered Warranty, the following **"Warranty Conditions"** are standard conditions that must be met for your TEGOLA CANADESE warranty to be valid. The Warranty Conditions include:

- The Limited Registered Warranty has been properly registered as above;
- The Date of Installation does not exceed 8 months from the Purchase of the Shingles as provided in the purchase invoice;
- The Shingles shall be installed using the most recent State of the Art, in accordance with both TEGOLA CANADESE's written installation instructions and local building code requirements;
- The Shingles shall be stored following the Storage Instructions written on each Shingles package;
- The person making the Warranty claim is the First Owner of the building, or the person to whom the Limited Registered Warranty was validly transferred as set out herein. For details on Warranty Transfers, please read "Transferability of Warranty" below;
- The Shingles have a manufacturing defect that has resulted in a leak;
- The entire repair or replacement job of the Shingles found defective, pursuant to this Limited Registered Warranty, must be done with TEGOLA CANADESE Material/Products.

Depending on the type of Shingles used, other conditions described herein may also apply for the TEGOLA CANADESE warranty to be valid or applicable.

Asphalt Shingle Limited Registered Warranty

2. LIMITED REGISTERED WARRANTY

Subject to the terms and conditions herein provided, TEGOLA CANADESE provides a Limited Registered Warranty from Manufacturing Defects on the Shingles purchased, to the benefit of the First Owner. Please see paragraph "Exclusions and Limitations"; the coverage provided by this Limited Registered Warranty is subject to the terms and conditions listed herein. The Limited Registered Warranty is limited to the Warranty Period starting from the Date of Purchase of the Shingle and it is valid only conditional upon official registration of the Limited Registered Warranty at the TEGOLA CANADESE Italian Headquarters as provided above; the duration of the Warranty Period is listed in the Information Table for each specific Shingles type installed on the First Owner's roof. The coverage given by this Limited Registered Warranty is meant to be given in the currency of the country in which the building is located. Except as otherwise provided, the Limited Registered Warranty is limited to the supply by TEGOLA CANADESE of the Shingles determined to be defected under the

conditions set out in this TC Limited Registered Warranty. The installation of the Shingles supplied in replacement shall be at sole responsibility of the First Owner or of the person to whom the Limited Registered Warranty has been duly transferred, according to this TC Limited Registered Warranty, who shall bear the relevant costs. TEGOLA CANADESE will only supply the necessary quantity of Shingles to replace the Shingles found defective, and only if TEGOLA CANADESE Shingles are used as replacement for the Shingles found defective. TEGOLA CANADESE reserves the irrevocable right to supply a similar alternative product, respected to the one for which this Warranty has been activated (for example because the product is no more produced).

3. MAX PROTECTION PERIOD

Tegola Canadese Srl offers Max Protection as set out below for every Shingle listed in the Information Table. The Max Protection Period starts on the Date of Purchase of Shingles by the Owner. This coverage is limited to the amount of time shown in the Information Table for your Shingles. During the Max

Protection Period, Tegola Canadese Srl will replace, free of charge, affected Shingles if all Warranty Conditions are met (the "Max Protection").

If there is a valid claim during the Max Protection Period, TEGOLA CANADESE's Maximum Liability is limited to the supply, free of charge, of the new Shingles to the Owner. This means that Tegola Canadese Srl will bear the costs of the replacement Shingles supplied similar to those already on the roof in the necessary quantity of Shingles to solve the problem on the roof of the Owner, and provided that the TEGOLA Shingles supplied are used as replacement shingles. Tegola Canadese shall also contribute to the installation costs, that will be reasonable and accepted in written by Tegola Canadese before the replacement works start. The contribution shall correspond to maximum the 80% of the original installation cost, as written in the invoice for installation (point D of documents to be provided in **1 Definitions – Limited Registered Warranty**) for issuing the Limited Registered Warranty. The above installation contribution is excluding any other costs and/or obligation and direct or indirect damage. Tegola Canadese Srl will supply the replacement Shingles FCA Incoterms @ 2020 Tegola Canadese Srl's factory. Other costs, such as tear-off, removal and disposal of the existing Shingles, flashings, metal work, vents and any other part of the roof or repair of any other damages or expenses incurred or claimed are not covered by the Max Protection or by other terms of the Limited Registered Warranty, including during the Max Protection Period.

4. BEYOND MAX PROTECTION PERIOD

Once the Max Protection Period expires, the Limited Registered Warranty provides to the Owner only a discount on the purchase of new Tegola Canadese Shingles, for a total value equal to the residual value indicated in the Information Table above. The total value is calculated by multiplying values arising from column 4 and/or 5 by the values written in Maximum Liability, as per the Information Table. This coverage during the Beyond Max Protection Period will apply only if the Warranty Conditions have been met.

Amount arising from this Limited Registered Warranty shall be deducted from the amount invoiced by Tegola Canadese Srl to the Owner for the purchase of the new Shingles. Shingles that shall be same type and same price of the originally purchased ones, only if TEGOLA Shingles are used as replacement shingles.

5. LIMITED WIND RESISTANCE COVERAGE

During the first 5 years after the Date of Purchase on the Owner's roof, the TEGOLA Shingles carry a Limited Warranty for wind "blow-off" for Shingles lost from the roof due to wind gusts which leads to leak. Each type of these Shingles, provided that the Shingles are installed in compliance with the installation instructions, carries a maximum wind resistance limit for this coverage. Please refer to the Information Table for the wind speed limits for each specific Model of Tegola Canadese.

For valid claims under the Limited Wind Resistance Warranty (where the Warranty Conditions are satisfied), TEGOLA CANADESE's Maximum Liability is to supply Shingles for replacement of those Shingles in the same quantity lost from the roof due to "blow-off". This means that Tegola Canadese Srl will bear the costs of the replacement Shingles supplied similar to those already on the roof, and provided that the TEGOLA Shingles supplied are used as replacement shingles. Tegola Canadese Srl will supply the replacement Shingles FCA Incoterms @ 2020 Tegola Canadese Srl's factory. Other costs, such as labor, tear-off, removal or disposal costs of Shingles, other shingles, roof, flashings, metal work, vents or repair of any other damages or expenses incurred or claimed, are not covered by the Limited Wind Resistance Warranty or otherwise.

6. NO LIMITED WIND RESISTANCE WARRANTY COVERAGE FOR WIND DAMAGE BEFORE SEALING STRIPS SEAL

All Shingles that contain a factory applied sealing strip must be subjected to warm temperatures for several days before full sealing will occur. In case of lack of adhesion due to cold temperatures, north orientated pitches, etc., the adhesion itself must be accelerated by the Contractor heating the sealing strips. Dust, sand or foreign matter will prevent the sealing strip from activating. This is the nature of shingles and failure to seal down under such circumstances is not a manufacturing defect. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to control and verify that the sealing strips have activated and that full sealing has occurred. Tegola Canadese Srl will not be responsible for any blow-offs or wind damage that may occur prior to thermal sealing having occurred. After the Shingles have been properly sealed according to TEGOLA CANADESE's Installation instructions, the Limited Registered Warranty that commenced at the Date of Purchase will cover wind damage, in accordance with the terms listed in the "Limited Wind Resistance Coverage" section, and it will be valid only if the installation systems (nails and other accessories) which shall be provided by Tegola Canadese Srl will objectively remain sealed to the support. Support means the underlayer (i.e. plywood or OSB) over which shingles are nailed. In the case TEGOLA Shingles are installed by torching them on an asphalt membrane, the Wind Resistance, the sealing of asphalt membrane to the

support and the sealing of Shingles to the asphalt membrane must be granted by the roofing contractor, by making a perfect installation.

7. LIMITED ALGAE RESISTANCE WARRANTY

If during the initial 12 months after the date of Purchase, your Shingles are discolored by blue-green algae (Cyanobacteria) growth, Tegola Canadese Srl will cover the cost, excluding labor costs, (such cost not to exceed the initial cost of the shingles) as reasonably determined by Tegola Canadese Srl to clean the affected shingles, subject to certain limitations. Tegola Canadese Srl will not cover any underlayment, metalwork, flashings or other related work and we will not cover the cost of tear off or dispose of your shingles. For purpose of this AR warranty, the term "repair" refers to cleaning or otherwise removing any blue-green algae growth from affected Shingles.

In case of blue-green algae growth, Tegola Canadese Srl will be responsible for the cleaning of the affected shingles as provided above. Alternatively, Tegola Canadese Srl may offer coverage of cleaning expenses (fix coverage, not prorated coverage) up to a maximum amount of 1 € per squaremeters, only once.

8. NON-TRANSFERABILITY OF LIMITED WARRANTY

This Limited Registered Warranty provides rights to, and can only be enforced by the First Owner, or to a person to whom the Limited Registered Warranty is allowed to be and is validly transferred as detailed below in the section titled "Limited Transferability of Limited Warranty". No other person or corporation can claim coverage or has rights under the Limited Registered Warranty.

9. LIMITED TRANSFERABILITY OF LIMITED REGISTERED WARRANTY

The Limited Registered Warranty for your Shingles is intended to primarily provide coverage only to the First Owner of the Shingles. Certain limited provisions of the Limited Registered Warranty and only for a limited period, as outlined below, may be transferred by the First Owner to the next property owner **only once** during the Limited Registered Warranty period, and only during the Max Protection Period of the Warranty Period. If the First Owner dies, the Limited Registered Warranty cannot be transferred to the heirs. In the absence of a permissible and valid transfer of the Limited Registered Warranty as set out herein, the Limited Registered Warranty ends on the sale or other transfer of the property.

To transfer certain provisions of the Limited Registered Warranty from the First Owner during the Max Protection Period of the Warranty Period, the First Owner must complete the following steps:

- Notification of a request for transfer must be received in writing by Tegola Canadese Srl – Italy to the email address: warranty@tegolacanedese.com within 30 days of the completion of the real estate transfer.

The transfer request must attach Tegola Canadese original Sales Invoice and/or Declaration from Tegola's customer with Tegola's original Sales Invoice Date and number, Production Batch, and all relevant information for issuing the Limited Registered Warranty; copy of the original Warranty Certificate issued by Tegola Canadese, and a copy of the property transfer documents (translated into English by a certified translator).

Upon the sale or transfer of the property, the Max Protection Period shall automatically terminate and for an allowable and valid transfer of the Limited Registered Warranty, the TEGOLA Shingles will then be covered for a limited Beyond Max Protection Period on a prorated basis for the Shingles only for a period of two (2) years following the transfer of the property. The Reduction Figure for these Shingles will be n/225.

10. EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS

Except as and limited to what is explicitly set out in this Limited Registered Warranty with respect to the Limited Wind Resistance Warranty, the coverage under this Limited Registered Warranty is only for Manufacturing Defects that result in a leak of the Shingles on the First Owner's roof, and for no other cause whatsoever. Conditions of the Shingles that do not result in a leak are not covered by the Limited Registered Warranty or otherwise.

As a result, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Tegola Canadese Srl will not have any liability or obligation under the Limited Warranty or otherwise for the following:

1. Any damage that occurs during or after any improper installation process, including one that fails to follow TEGOLA CANADESE's printed installation instructions;

2. Any damage or improper installation process due to the fact that have not been used original TEGOLA CANADESE accessories for installation such as, but not limited to, Bitustick Underlayers, Ventilators and Nails. In the case of torch on installation on asphalt waterproofing membrane, also asphalt membrane original Tegola Canadese purchase shall be required. In the case of installation with nails, it is required to use one of the original underlayers supplied by Tegola Canadese Srl. All these items must appear in the purchase Invoice required to register the Limited Registered Warranty.

3. Any variation in the color or shading between installed Shingles on the building, including the fading or weathering of colored granules used in any of TEGOLA's Shingle blends, shading, weathering, oxidization of metal-laminated tiles or due to stops of manufacturing process or modification of a specific product.
4. Any damage to the interior or exterior of any building, or any property or contents within or outside the building;
5. Any damage caused by Acts of God or other causes beyond TEGOLA CANADESE's control, including, without limitation, lightning, gale or wind (except for the coverage provided in the Limited Wind Resistance Warranty, where applicable), hail, hurricane, tornado, earthquake, explosion, flood, fungus contamination, solid objects falling on the roof, or any other causes.
6. Any damage caused by settlement, distortion or cracking of the roof deck, walls or foundation of the building. This includes failure in the materials used as a support for Shingles, or by the presence of people, animals, machinery, equipment or any traffic of any kind on the roof;
7. Any damage to the Shingles caused by the Installation made on not-seasoned wood that might not grant a uniform level of the roof and cause buckling of Shingles;
8. Any damage that may arise as a consequence of any roof alteration. This includes any alteration including structural additions, changes, or replacement; or equipment installations (including but not limited to, signs, water towers, air conditioning equipment, solar heaters, water heaters, solar panels, television and /or radio antennas, satellite dishes, skylights, and equipment or machinery of any kind);
9. Any costs incurred for any work, repairs or replacements not authorized in advance in writing by Tegola Canadese Srl;
10. Costs incurred for materials, repairs or replacements of materials not produced by Tegola Canadese Srl;
11. Any damage that arises from any cause other than a manufacturing defect that results in a leak;
12. Any discoloration or damage due to the presence of mold, mildew, fungus, algae, biological growth or pollutant or other matter on the Shingles or roof (except for the coverage provided in the Limited Algae Resistance Warranty, where applicable);
13. Any damage or distortion caused by inadequate ventilation either at the eaves or on the rooftop of the building. This includes failure of ventilation caused by blocked, non-operative or defective vents or any other condition that renders the ventilation system ineffective.
14. Any costs related to the replacement of the Shingles that is not expressly covered in this Limited Registered Warranty. This means that this Limited Registered Warranty does not cover the cost of tear-off, removal and disposal of Shingles, flashings, metalwork, vents or repair of any other damages caused by or associated with any leakage, or any other costs or expenses the Owner may incur or claim;
15. Any damages due to Shingles directly installed on thermal insulation panels;
16. Any Shingle product sold with or bearing "NO WARRANTY" tape or marking on the original Sales Invoice. Such Shingle product is sold on an "As Is" no warranty basis;

11. NO LIABILITY OR COVERAGE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES

The Limited Registered Warranty provides coverage only for certain limited damage to Shingles that is directly caused by a manufacturing defect.

IN NO EVENT SHALL Tegola Canadese Srl OR ITS AFFILIATES BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, ASSOCIATED, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES. This means, without limiting the foregoing, that this Limited Registered Warranty does not cover claims for: damages to homes or other structures, interiors, exteriors, furniture, contents, appliances, loss of income, loss of enjoyment, storage fees, economic loss, or any other loss or damage.

12. LIMITED COVERAGE FOR REPLACEMENT SHINGLES

If Tegola Canadese Srl provides coverage under this Limited Registered Warranty for a submitted claim, the replacement Shingles are covered by the Limited Registered Warranty only for the remainder of the Warranty Period starting from the Date of Purchase of the replaced Shingles.

13. SPECIFIC WARRANTY FOR ULITMETAL HD

This warranty concerns the aluminum coated by PVDF coil coating system that covers the Ultimetal HD shingles of TEGOLA CANADESE. This warranty becomes effective when the paint film under the hereinafter stated condition is found to:

1. Peel, crack on the surface of coil coated sheet

Any defect must be recognized by naked eye investigation vertically from a distance of 2 (two) meters.

2. Fade or change in color

Fading or changing is not excess as determined in accordance with the procedures outlined in ASTM D2244-93 measured on the exposed painted

surfaces which have been cleaned of external deposits (dirt, oil, grease, foreign material, oxidized film, etc.). The colour will not fade or change color in excess of 5 Hunter units when measured according to ASTM D2244. It is understood that fading or color changes may not be uniform if the surfaces are not equally exposed to the sun and natural elements.

3. Chalk

Chalk will not exceed numerical ratings described on the ASTM D 3964, when measured in accordance with the standard procedure specified in ASTM D 4214-89 method D659 on a clean surface after removing dirt and other surface deposit. In particular, this warranty becomes effective when the values indicated in Table 4.1 will be exceeded.

4. Warranty terms

4.1 Table of the warranty terms

4.2 This warranty applies to bitumen shingles with pre-painted aluminum sheet of TEGOLA CANADESE called "Ultimetal HD". This PRODUCT is used for roofing and wall applications and installed on buildings in EU and Non—EU countries and it has the following validity:

- a. Low-risk countries warranty level (more than 30 degrees latitude north/south)

4.3 This warranty is valid under the following conditions:

- 4.3.1 The PRINT-COAT aluminum paint finish as supplied must not be scratched, abraded, or damaged in any way, or coated with an incompatible material;
- 4.3.2 Sheltered areas or areas unwashed by rain exposure must be washed down on a regular 6 (six) monthly basis. Corrosion arising in unwashed areas will not be covered by this warranty;
- 4.3.3 The PRODUCT, as Supplied, must not at any time come into contact with an incompatible material, as for example:

1	Hazardous fumes or debris in the air, or salt spray
2	Water stagnant on the coated side
3	Animal excrements
4	Detergents used for cleaning
5	Concrete, Mortar, Soil, Ash, Fertilizie, Moisture Material
6	Lead or copper and other similar metals

7	Liquid on the contact surface of copper-based roof and wall or contact with liquids from copper pipes
8	Contact with liquids from wet or green timber or treated wood
9	Attack from chemical or other agents, fumes, liquids or solids other than direct rain or run-off falling onto the PRODUCT
10	Penetration from vapors, liquids or solids
11	Proximity to harshly polluted area, severely wet area, extremely hot area and chemical or steel industries. UV region over 160 (klys/yr)
12	Sea salt, harsh industrial zone, or unusually corrosive environment at any time in the future

- 4.3.4 The application of post paint treatment or system to the PRODUCT will invalidate this warranty.
- 4.3.5 All flashings, fasteners or components fixed to or used with the PRODUCT must be installed with PRIN- COAT on galvanized steel, aluminum substrates or materials approved by Tegola Canadese Srl. Regardless of the approving, corrosion near drilling and screwing area due to the damage on the clear coating of the aluminum surface will invalidate this warranty. All flashings, fasteners or components fixed to or used with the PRODUCT must be installed with the Tegola Canadese's bituminous mastic "Bitustick".
- 4.3.6 Installed pitch of the roof is equal to greater than 5 degrees above the horizontal.
- 4.3.7 The roof is fully lined and does not contain unexposed eaves or other areas sheltered or unwashed by natural rainfall.
- 4.3.8 The walling must not be protected from washing by natural rainfall due to structures including, without limitation, canopies, patios, carports or verandas, other than by eaves which extend no greater than 600mm out from the wall.
- 4.3.9 This warranty will apply to PRODUCTS installed on a surface placed greater than 1 km from salt water (coast or canal) and abnormal exposure areas: areas of corrosive exposure such as, but not limited to, exposure to saltwater spray or exposure to, strong acidic or alkaline emissions, such as those in the vicinity of paper mills, fertilizer plants, aluminum processing plants, copper smelters and similar operations.

4.4 Exclusions. This warranty will not cover defects due to the following causes:

- 4.4.1 Damage to the coating due to an improper processing, handling or installation;
- 4.4.2 Defects attributed to faulty design, method of handmade not correct, as for example corrosion arising within lapped areas of end-lapped sheets or corrosion at cut edges;
- 4.4.3 Failure to replace corroded fasteners;
- 4.4.4 Damages or failures which are occurring from natural disaster, fire, flood, explosion, falling stone, acts of war, riots, vandalism, salt spray, atomic radiation, typhoons, other similarly extreme 'acts of God';
- 4.4.5 Failure to remove debris and/or failure to provide free drainage of water including internal condensation from all surfaces of the PRODUCT;
- 4.4.6 With regard to paint delamination (peel or flake), the internal facing surface of the PRODUCT (No peel off).

14. SEVERABILITY

In case any provision hereof is held to be void, illegal, invalid, or unenforceable in whole or in part, it shall not affect the legality, validity or enforceability of the remainder hereof.

15. NOTIFICATION OF CLAIMS

1. Claims must be submitted to Tegola Canadese Srl within the guarantee period and within seven (7) days after defect has been discovered, sending an e-mail to claims@tegolacanedese.com.
2. The request of warranty, in order to be valid, must contain all the following information: complete data of the First Owner, Copy of the Registered Certificate of Warranty, description of the problem claimed, Clear pictures of the damage and of the claimed shingles, Exact address of the building where the claim occurred, Email address and phone number of the applicant, Acceptance of the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation). - Commitment in giving to Tegola Canadese any information or documentation required by TEGOLA CANADESE.
3. In case of Ultimetal HD Shingles, three samples taken from the Roof to be sent to Tegola Canadese with the proof of shipment (AWB or similar) (at applicant expenses and responsibility) via Courier.
4. The applicant when sending the Notification of Claim must also grant access(es) to Tegola Canadese if so required by Tegola Canadese, collection of samples on site, video and pictures registering of the claimed area. Access to the building, both inside and outside, shall be granted to Tegola with prior notice of five (5) days. The applicant must grant to Tegola Canadese representatives, with expenses at its own full charge, a safe access to the roofing, by respecting the local safety laws. In case the applicant denies the access and/or fails in answering within the next 10 days from request of Tegola Canadese, and/or does not prepare the safety equipment, the Limited Registered Warranty shall automatically terminate.

Within sixty (60) days from the Request of Warranty and/or sending documentation/information to Tegola Canadese, Tegola Canadese shall send official reply.

16. IMPORTANT NOTICES

This Limited Registered Warranty replaces all other oral or written warranties, liabilities or obligations of Tegola Canadese Srl. There are no other warranties which extend beyond the limited warranty described in this document. Tegola Canadese Srl will not be liable for any oral statement or other written statement about any TEGOLA Shingle, whether such statements are made by an agent or employee of Tegola Canadese Srl or by any other person. Tegola Canadese Srl does not authorize its representatives, distributors, contractors or dealers to make any changes or modifications to this Limited Registered Warranty. This Limited Registered Warranty is governed by Italian law with the exclusion of the provisions of the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods (Vienna, 1980) (CISG). EXCEPT WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW, THE OBLIGATION CONTAINED IN THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS EXPRESSLY IN LIEU OF ANY OTHER OBLIGATIONS, WARRANTIES, CAUSES OF ACTION, CONDITIONS, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED CONDITION OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. EXCEPT FOR THE OBLIGATION EXPRESSLY CONTAINED IN THIS LIMITED REGISTERED WARRANTY, LIABILITY OF TEGOLA CANADESE SRL IS EXCLUDED RELATING TO, IN CONNECTION WITH, OR ARISING FROM, ANY RIGHT, CLAIM, REMEDY AND CAUSE OF ACTION AGAINST TEGOLA CANADESE OR ANY OF ITS AFFILIATED OR RELATED COMPANIES, OR THEIR AGENTS, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS AND EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, STRICT LIABILITY, STATUTE, TORT, NEGLIGENCE, WAIVER OF TORT AND INDIRECT, ASSOCIATED, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES. MANDATORY BINDING ARBITRATION: EVERY CLAIM, CONTROVERSY OR DISPUTE OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER BETWEEN YOU AND TEGOLA CANADESE SRL OR ITS AFFILIATED (INCLUDING ANY OF THEIR EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS) RELATING TO OR ARISING OUT OF THE SHINGLES OR THIS LIMITED WARRANTY SHALL BE RESOLVED BY IN TREVISO (ITALY) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF CURIA MERCATORUM (WWW.CURIAMERCATORUM.COM)..

This Limited Warranty applies to TEGOLA CANADESE Shingles sold on or after 1st September 2023 and supersedes all previously published warranties.
